

How to ride public transit:

- ❶ Check out the routes and schedules. A Peterborough Transit Map with this information was provided with the pass. It is also available online.
- ❷ Use the map to find out which route will take you to your destination. Check out the pick-up and drop-off times.
- ❸ Plan your trip.
- ❹ Find the nearest bus stop.
- ❺ At the right time, wait at the stop and have your pass ready.*
- ❻ When the bus arrives, move to the door nearest the driver. Let passengers get off the bus, then get on the bus.
- ❼ Show your pass to the driver.
- ❽ Find a seat. The seats near the front of the bus are reserved for older adults or people with disabilities.
- ❾ Before your stop, pull the hanging cord or press a button to signal to the driver that you want to get off.
- ❿ When the bus stops, thank the driver and get off. You may exit through the rear doors.

BE AWARE - Transit buses move away from the stop as soon as passengers have gotten on or off. As soon as you get off the bus, you need to be alert. You should never cross the street in front of a transit bus. Wait for the bus to pull away so you have a clear view of the street. Cross at the cross walk or street corner.

*During Transit Quest, you ride for FREE. The normal fare is \$2.25 or \$7 for a day pass.
